One of the most prominent players to compete in men's basketball at Michigan Tech, Bill Massey played for the Huskies from 1960-64. A four-year letter winner, Massey accumulated 943 points in 83 total games. He helped the Huskies to the 1962-63 Northern State College Conference title, a year in which the Huskies achieved a 17-5 overall record. For his efforts, Massey gained All-NSCC Second Team recognition. His senior season, one in which Massey served as team captain, Michigan Tech moved to the Northern Intercollegiate Conference where he earned Second Team All-NIC honours. During his stay at MTU, Massey was involved in more than just athletics. He not only captained MTU's College Bowl Team in 1964, but he was also a member of both Blue Key National Honour Society and the IFC Council. Following graduation from MTU, Massey went on to play for two years in Luxembourg in the National League. He also spent time playing in Peru, Mexico, and Brazil.

Arthur Beatty Jr. was inducted into AU's Stafford H. Cassell Hall of Fame on Feb. 5, just months after his untimely death in the summer of 2004. AU's third alltime leading rebounder, the seven-feet one-inch Beatty's interests varied widely off the court. He is survived by his wife, Elisa, and their children, Remy, Alicia, and Kahlil. The following originally appeared in the summer 2001 edition of American magazine.
When Arthur Beatty '68 graduated from AU, his name peppered the men's basketball team record books. Over seven-feet tall and with flowing athletic grace, Beatty had several offers from the NBA, and that would have been fine-if Beatty considered himself only a basketball player. Unfortunately for the NBA, Beatty is so much more-actor, musician, painter-the type of man who dreads bedtime if only because he has to stop living for a spell.
"Basketball was a means to an end," Beatty says. "There was just no time for anything other than basketball in the NBA." Beatty, an interior design and architecture major at $A U$, signed with Racing Mechelen, a Belgian pro team whose season was one-third as long as that of the NBA, enabling him to attend graduate school at the Antwerp Academy of Fine Arts.

Thus began a love affair with Europe that has endured for the last 30 years. "I've never regretted coming to Europe," says Beatty, who currently lives in Paris. He has filled his life with acting (he's been in four movies, including one with Orson Welles, and several plays), music (he plays a six-foot Japanese zither called a koto), and art, lots of art. Beatty's jazz visuals, marker drawings of jazz greats that he sketches while they play, have won him renown. "I've found my avocation is my vocation. It's the spirit of invention that I love. The ability to create something new," he says.

A four-time most valuable player for the Juniata College men's basketball program, Mark Rucinski was the lone College Hill player, at the time of his induction, to score over 1,000 points and pull down 1,000 rebounds in his career. As of November 4, 2000, he was first on the career rebounding chart $(1,002)$ and sixth on the all-time scoring list $(1,310)$ at Juniata. During his junior season, he established a blue and gold single-season record for rebounds (309). His senior total of 281 caroms ranks fourth on the same list. Overall, he averaged 14.6 points and 11.1 rebounds per game throughout his Juniata tenure. A two-year captain, he made an immediate impact on the men's basketball program by shattering a backboard while dunking a basketball during his first day on campus. During a 10-day trip to Belgium his junior year, he was named the most valuable player of the Gembloux Holiday Tournament. Following graduation, he played three years professionally in France and Luxembourg and averaged 30+ points and $15+$ rebounds during his career.

This player looks like a disabled sportsman. Thickly bandaged knees, walks with a stoop thin as a rake - no one would take him for a player. But they would be wrong. Stanislav Kropilak is among the best basketball players in Europe. This giant (2.10m) from Bratislava is the player with the record number of internationals in his country. He has been selected than for the European Champ team and was the best scorer of the basketball tournaments in Moscow in 1980. The power of the CSSR team stands or falls with him. The tallest player is also the greatest.

What makes this doddering center so valuable? This precise timing of the rebound, his extremely long apelike arms and his infallible instinct of be turning up present at the right time in the right place. Even though this 30-year-old player arouses our compassion-during the European championship's it's his opposite number alone for whom we should feel sorry.

On Tuesday, April 26, 2011 the Kennesaw State University Department of Intercollegiate Athletics will name Lewis Preston as the fourth head men's basketball coach in program history. Preston is one of the up-and-coming coaches in college basketball, and has developed a strong recruiter and developer of post players during his 13 years in collegiate coaching.

Preston comes to Kennesaw from Penn State, where he spent three years on the coaching staff under Ed DeChellis. During his tenure in Happy Valley, Preston helped guide the Nittany Lions to levels of success the program had not seen in years, making their first NCAA Tournament appearance this past March for the first time since 2001 and winning the NIT Tournament during his first season on staff in 2008-09.

Prior to his time at Penn State, Preston spent two years as an assistant coach on Billy Donovan's staff at Florida and before that spent six years under Mike Brey at Notre Dame. Florida won the second of its back-to-back national championships in Preston's first year on the Gators' staff, where he was an integral part of Florida's recruiting, scouting, game preparation and on-court teaching.

Preston worked with 2007 first-round NBA draft picks Joakim Noah, Al Horford and Corey Brewer and second-round selection Taurean Green while at Florida. At Notre Dame he had the opportunity to work with two first-round draft picks in back-to-back seasons in Troy Murphy (2001) and Ryan Humphrey (2002) as well as current NBA players Matt Carroll and Chris Quinn.

During his time on the Notre Dame staff, Preston was instrumental in the development of the Irish post players and earned a reputation as a highly regarded national recruiter. He helped the Irish to a 118-70 (.628) mark in six years in South Bend, including three NCAA Tournament appearances and a

Sweet 16 showing in 2003. The Irish reached the postseason in each of Preston's six years at Notre Dame.
A 1993 graduate of Virginia Military Institute, Preston spent four years playing professionally in Europe with stints in Luxembourg, Ireland and Finland. In his first season in Luxembourg, he averaged 25.0 points, 11.0 rebounds and three blocks per game and continued to average a double-double in points and rebounds throughout his professional career.

Preston had an outstanding collegiate career after playing just one season at Franklin County (Va.) High School. He began as a walk-on at VMI, but left as just the 21st 1,000-point scorer in school history and a school-record holder in four categories. Preston's 1,146 career point's rank 24th on the VMI scoring list.

As a senior, Preston led the Keydets in scoring (16.7), rebounding (7.1), field-goal percentage (.540), free-throw percentage (.800) and blocked shots (48). During the 1992-93 campaign, Preston scored in double figures in all but four of VMI's 27 contests and had 20 or more points on seven occasions.

Preston is the school's record holder in career blocked shots (202), registering the top two blocked shot seasons in Keydet history, including a school-record 65 in 1992 and 64 in 1991. Preston is second all-time in VMI history for blocked shots in a game, swatting seven shot attempts against Marshall in 1992.

A two-time all-Southern Conference selection, Preston led the league in blocked shots twice and finished as its second all-time shot-blocking leader. He concluded his career at the Lexington, Va., school with averages of 10.6 points and 5.7 rebounds per game.

Born Oct. 31, 1970, Preston graduated from VMI with a bachelor's degree in history and a minor in English literature. He married the former Angela Sangermano in May of 2001. The couple has two daughters, Alexandra, born in December of 2002, and Emma, born in January of 2005.

This is the sixth in a series profiling the 2011 inductees of the Port Huron Sports Hall of Fame.

Whether he was throwing down a dunk or smashing a forehand winner, Jon Zulauf was a force on the courts.

Zulauf, a 1988 Port Huron High graduate, and his twin, Jay, sparked the Big Reds' basketball success from 1985-88.

Jon, 42, along with Jay, will be inducted Saturday night into the Port Huron Sports Hall of Fame at the Thomas Edison Inn.
"This will be my first Hall of Fame banquet," said Jon, who made the trip with his family from Naperville, III. to St. Clair Thursday afternoon.
"I talked with coach (Tom) Izzo recently and told him l'll have to behave with Lloyd Carr being the guest speaker. He said he just did a charity event with Carr and he's a great guy."
Jon and his wife, Tracy, have two daughters, Jenna and Ashley, and a son, Brian.
"I haven't played basketball in a long time," Jon said. "My mind says yes, but my body says no. I want to be able to walk when I'm 50.
"We're keeping busy with the kids. I coach Brian's fifth-grade basketball team and having a blast."

Jon earned a scholarship to MSU and played 99 games in his four-year career. He had a career-high 19-point game and 10-rebound contest.

The 6-foot-7 forward was a member of the 1990 Big Ten championship team. He was a key reserve his sophomore, junior and senior seasons while starting four games as a senior.

While at Port Huron High, Jon and Jay played for the late Ed Peltz.

As a sophomore, Jon, a left-hander, was a first-team all-Eastern Michigan League, all-area, all-Metro East and honorable mention all-state. He averaged 16 points and eight rebounds a game.

Jon compiled a 26-0 record playing No. 3 singles before giving up tennis to concentrate on basketball.

Jon averaged 21 points per game, shot $60 \%$ from the field and $74 \%$ from the free-throw line in leading the Big Reds to the EML title. He was voted the team most valuable player and earned first-team all-state honors.

The Big Reds posted a 24-2 record Jon's senior season, including Class A district and regional titles. They lost 66-59 to top-ranked Detroit Southwestern in the state quarterfinals.
"I still think if Jay hadn't been sick and (Kevin) Nicefield didn't have the eye problems, we could have beat them." Jon said. "We had a great team."

Jon averaged 24 points and 11 rebounds per game. Besides league, allarea and all-state honors, he was named to the Nike All-American team and the McDonalds All-American Team, He was rated one of the top 60 players in the country and rated No. 4 in the state.

Jon still holds Port Huron High season and career rebound records and field goal percentage.

After completing his career at MSU, Jon played professional basketball for three years in Austria for UBSC-Graz with a team-record 55 points in one game while averaging 32 points per game.
Jon and Jay were named to St. Clair County's Top 50 Best Athletes list by the Times Herald.
